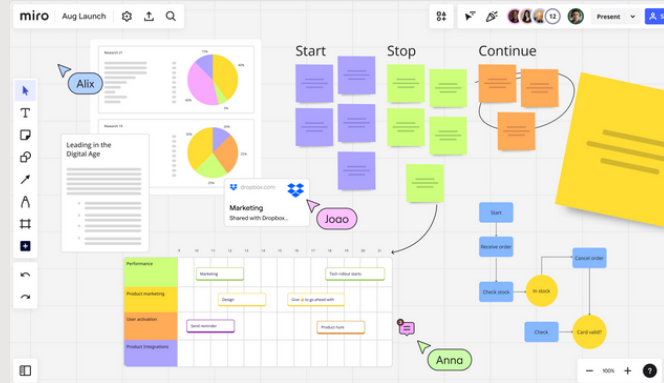


Info Sheet for the Miro Training

Certificate of Attendance

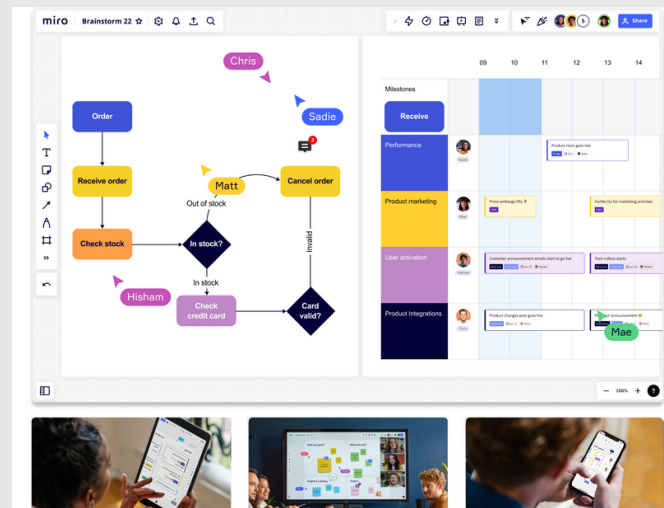
A certificate of attendance will be granted to those of the participants who attended all four sessions and completed the tasks Bob Nguyen asks for.

Details of the Training

We want the participants in this training to leave with a high level of confidence about using Miro in adaptive instruction and personalized learning. For this reason, there will be 4 modules that are going to take place online on the Zoom platform on Wednesday evenings (Dec 13, Dec 20 and Dec 27) from 8pm to 9:30pm, and the fourth and last meeting is going to be held face-to-face on January 3rd to share the materials we will have created on Miro, followed by a social event on the same day.



Content of the Training

Day 1 – Brainstorming about the uses of Miro (both for personalized learning and adaptive instruction) Learn about the technical features and tools on Miro by creating a brainstorm board.

Day 2 – Exploring different uses of Miro, seeing actual examples, and beginning to design graphic organizers such as concept maps and diagrams.

Day 3 – Refining and learning how to present our materials to be used in a course or presentation.

Day 4 – Gallery: Sharing the materials we will have created on Miro with others and receiving feedback.
